### Grad Photos

You **MUST** get your photo taken to be in the Yearbook and Grad Composite for the hallway.

You **MUST** purchase your **Cap and Gown** prior to Grad photos as the photographer cannot provide a cap and gown due to Covid restrictions.

For a Grad photo package, the sitting fee is \$20.00 – this is a new price! Sitting Fee is paid to the photographer.

There is no sitting fee if you just want your photo in the yearbook and on the Grad composite.

## Things you need to know!

### **Please read prior to your Grad Photo:**

1. The sitting fee is \$20.00.

You will receive a 5x7 diploma folder, a 5x7 grad photo and a 5x7 photo from the Commencement Ceremony. Cash, cheque or credit card only – no debit. This is paid to the photographer.

2. You need to arrive 10 minutes early for your appointment. You are responsible for your own gown and stole. You can wear your cap if you wish, but you will be required to put it on yourself. The photographer will have a tassel you can use.

3. Please do not wear a T-shirt - a shirt and tie or blouse looks best under the grad gown.

4. No pets.

5. No group photos or photos with friends or siblings – individual photos only.

6. Small props that can be held are okay – but we need to stay touchless with everything.

7. There will be no diploma photos.

8. The photographer will take 8 photographs of each grad.

### **Taking your Cap and Gown home:**

After your Grad photos – you need to take your cap, gown and grad stole home with you.

**Please keep your graduation items safely stored for our Commencement ceremony in June.**

We do not have extra caps, gowns or stoles to give in June.
